Status of Mohyal girls after marriage to a non-mohyal: The house discussed at length the issue of status enjoyed in the Community, by Mohyal girls whose parents are forced to marry them to non-Mohyals a Mohyal boy marrying a non-Mohyal girl remains in Mohyal fold whereas a Mohyal girl marrying a non-Mohyal boy ceases to be Mohyal. This tantamount to discrimination between a male and a girl child. GMS has always championed the cause of equality of genders. There are several Mohyals who are blessed with daughters only who have been brought up in Mohyal traditions suddenly find themselves out of Mohyal Community on their marriage to a non-Mohyal.

Children of such girls are grandchildrel of Mohyal grandparents. Such girls may have enrolled as Life member of a Sabha/GMS before marriage and even after marriage to a non-Mohyal keep on making donations to GMS for Langar Fund, on birthday of their children and death anniversary of their Mohyal parents.

We regret to announce the passing away of our father, Shri Pran Nath Bakshi on 29th December 2014. He was the s/



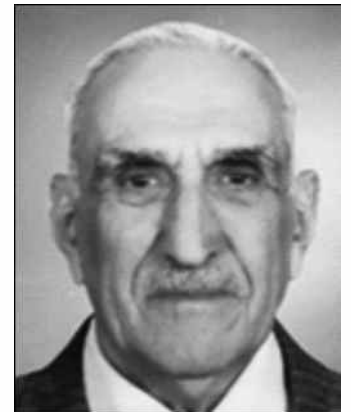
