Mohyal Ratna S K Chhibber, IAS, former Governor of Mizoram

It is with great grief and profound sorrow we mourn the passing away of one of the very tallest and finest Mohyals, Mohyal Ratna late Shri SK Chhibber, IAS who left for his heavenly abode on 24 Feb 2016 at Delhi.

He was born at Sialkot in Jan 1920, studied at prestigious FC College Lahore and was commissioned into Royal Indian Artillery in 1943, but was soon selected for Indian Civil Services, after clearing Federal Public Service Commission exam (now UPSC) and was sent to Bengal province. After Independence he was inducted into the IAS and allotted Punjab Cadre. He was Deputy Commissioner, Hoshiarpur, Jalandhar and Amritsar — his father late Bakshi Sansar Chand Chhibber was President MS Jalandhar for several years. He was Commissioner Ambala Division and Home Secretary Punjab. He was also VC of Punjab Agricultural University. On formation of Haryana, he was allotted Haryana cadre. Thereafter he served under the Central Govt in several posts including Chief Secretary of Delhi. He was appointed as Lt Governor of Mizoram in June 1974 and retired in 1978 after a tenure as Secretary to Govt of India.

He was a very active member of the Community and was a consistent donor. He was elected as the President of the 47th All India Mohyal Conference held at Delhi in 1982. In 1984 he got a plot of land allotted to the GMS in the Qutab Institutional Area, where we have the Mohyal Foundation Building housing the GMS Secretariat and MERIT for which the community will always remain indebted to him. The GMS, the apex body of the Community honoured him by conferring on him the highest title of Mohyal Ratna in the 51st All India Mohyal Conference held at Delhi in Jan 2012, for his continuous selfless service to the Community. He will always be remembered as an soft spoken upright honest officer, philanthropist, totally grounded with his roots, an excellent human being and a great soul, we will always remember with love and affection.

Prayer meeting of Mohyal Ratna Shri S K Chhibber, IAS was held at Chinmaya Mission, Lodhi Road on 27 Feb 2016, which was attended by large number of his friends, colleagues, relatives and members of the community including Rzd B D Bali, President GMS, members of Managing Committee and representatives from many local Sabhas.

Rzd B D Bali, President GMS and members of the Managing Committee convey their heartfelt condolences to the bereaved family and pray to God Almighty with folded hands to grant peace to the departed noble great soul and give strength to the close knit family to bear with this great loss. A LEGENDARY MOHYAL PASSES AWAY

Mohyal Rattan, Bakshi S.K. Chhibber had become so much an integral part of all of us for almost four decades that his passing away has shocked everyone. While we sorrowfully mourn his sudden loss, we have to concede that Chhibber Sahib lived a full life as an icon of the highest order. Tall, handsome and dignified, highly educated, selected into ICS and then IAS on his own merits, he held various top key assignments with the Government culminating as Lt. Governor of Mizoram - bringing lot of glory to himself, to the family and to the Mohyal Community.

Despite being a legend in many ways, he was humble, soft spoken, compassionate, good hearted and epitome of many other virtues which made him an excellent human being.

But he lived life on his own terms and never compromised on his principles of ethics, norms and values and was known to be highly upright in every sphere.



When I joined GMS in 1978 I approached him for his association in social work for the community and he readily agreed but on one condition that he would not hold any office. Thereafter, over the last many decades he got himself involved in all Mohyal activities and endeared himself to every Mohyal with his amiable disposition and manners - who looked at him with lot of respect. His crowning glory was acquisition of a plot for GMS in Qutab Institutional Area, New Delhi which now houses two buildings of Mohyal Foundation with offices of GMS and MERIT for which the community will be ever grateful to him.

Chhibber Sahib always had great concerns for the under-privileged sections of the society and two years back had formed a Trust of about Rs. 3 crores in the name of his father Bakshi Sansar Chand Chhibber which aims at helping the "have nots" towards education and health care. Since these objectives are similar to the one of GMS, he always hoped and wished that besides others, Mohyal community should be suitably benefited.

The life or death are in His Hands but good actions, noble deeds and above all humanistic approach keeps the memory alive, and though physically Chhibber Sahib would not be with us, I am sure his name will always shine out and he will continue to inspire and shower his blessings to the community from heaven for it to blossom and prosper.

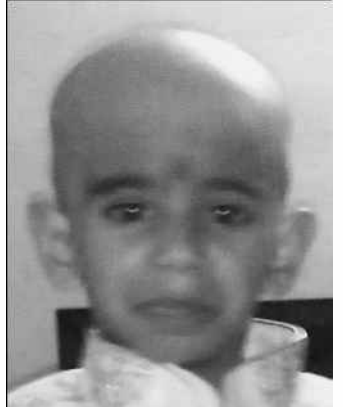

Mohyal Community's Contribution in the Battle of Karbala

In 680 AD when Imam Hasan (Prophet's grandson) died due to poisoning, his younger brother, Imam Hussain, refused to pay allegiance to the new Khalifa Yazid ibn Muawiyah. To avoid any confrontation, Imam Hussain left his home in Mecca for Medina and from there went to Kufa in present day Iraq. When they reached Karbala, the army of Yazid surrounded the group consisting of mere 200 men and women, including 72 members of his family. In the war where hardly any Muslim came to help him, Rahib Sidh Datt, a Mohyal Brahma, who had close relations with the family of Muhammad and was a highly respected figure in Arabia, came to help Hussain. On the seventh day of Moharram, a strong army of 30,000 soldiers sent by Caliph Yazid from Mecca and other places surrounded their camp. 6000 soldiers guarded the river bank to ensure that not a drop of water reached the camp where Hussain, his friends and family were encircled without food and water for days. By the sunset of 10th (Ashoor) a Friday, all were dead. Imam Hussain himself was slain with thirtythree strokes of lances and swords.

Rahib Datt chased the murderers as they ran with the severed head of Hussein up to Kufa. He retrieved Imam Hussain's head, washed it reverently and then carried it to Damascus. According to the legend he was overtaken by Yazid's men during his overnight shelter on the way. They demanded Hussain's head from him. Rehab executed the head of one of his sons and offered to them. They shouted that it was not Hussain's head. Then Rehab beheaded his second son and they again yelled that it was not Hussain's head. In this way he executed the heads of his seven sons but did not part with the head of Imam Hussain. Later, the head was carried to Damascus and was finally buried in Kerbala with the rest of his body.

Subsequently, the Dutts rallied around Amir Mukhtar, the chief of the disciples of Imam Hussain, fought with extraordinary heroism and captured and razed the fort of Koofa, seat of Yazid's Governor. Later on, when Sunnis let loose an orgy of vendetta on Shias and Datts, Rehab overwhelmed with grief over the slaughter of his seven sons, migrated to Afghanistan via Iran and Turkistan. Rahab datt returned to India in 728 AD and the community to which he belonged adopted the name, Hussaini Brahmins, signifying his close bond with Imam Hussain and the fact that they were Hindu Brahmins. It is also significant to note that even before the Karbala incident, Hazrat Ali during the battle of Camels fought between Ali and Yazid's father Omayyad Khalifa had entrusted the public exchequer on the regiment of the valiant Dutts. This provides impeccable evidence about the prominent role played by Mohyals in the history of Karbala and the respect, admiration and prominence they enjoyed in Arabia.

According to another version, Rahab resided in Arabia and had no children. He heard of prophet Mohammed and Imam Hussain and went to meet them to seek their blessing for children. Subsequently, Rahab became father of 7 sons and he always remembered that his sons were the blessings of Imam Hussain. When the battle of Karbala was over, the Yazid army took the ladies of Imam Hussain and his companions in captivity and headed towards Syria. Rahab used to stay on the way towards Syria. One night Yazid's army was passing by from his area. It was a night time so the army decided to

halt there. The commander of the army wanted a safe place to keep Imam Hussain's slaughtered head so that no other army person could take it and claim the prize offered by Yazid. He found a small temple kind of place and called the owner, Rahab Dutt and forced him to keep the head in his temple. At midnight Rahab was worried about what has been kept in his temple. He went there and bought the head of Imam in his house. Rahab started crying and asked all his 7 sons to save the head of Imam being taken away. They fought the oppressors but were killed in the ensuing battle. The followers of Imam Hussain have not forgotten the sacrifices of Rehab Dutt and his family and Mohyals (called Hussaini Brahmins) are looked upon with great respect and admiration.

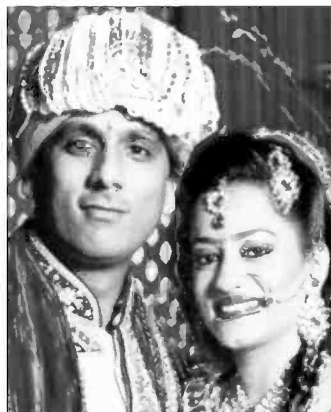

HEART TO HEART

Respected members of the Biradari,

Wishing you a blessed new year 2016. Since this is the first article in a series, I would like to convey my sincere thanks and gratitude to the Editor (Col Vaid) and his team who gave me



this opportunity to connect with my Community and also to share my experience as a doctor and more so as an Orthopaedic Surgeon with you.

Being born to a teacher mother and a doctor father, as a child I had the best of both worlds, a home where education and care for others were ingrained in us. No wonder that my elder sister became a teacher and myself a doctor. I was born in Delhi, got my degrees- MBBS and MS in Delhi. For higher and specialized training in tele-

scopic surgery for joints and joint reconstruction surgeries I travelled and worked in Canada and UK and in top hospitals in Mumbai and Delhi. After 17 years as an Orthopaedic Surgeon and treating thousands of patients, it is time to serve my own Mohyal Biradari. My mother Smt Premlata Mehta is still active in most of the Mohyal meetings. My father Late Dr R K Mehta was one of the early donors for Mohyal Ashram, Haridwar. And I can share this with pride that his name is engraved on the walls of the ashram, amongst the visionaries and philanthropists of the biradari.

Through these articles, I plan to cover a wide range of health related issues, common ailments, life-style problems, youth related issues such as stress, bad habits, and problems faced by elderly including preventive and curative methods.

DENGUE FEVER

Please note that the article is only informative and nothing can replace treatment from a qualified doctor.

What: Dengue fever is a painful mosquito-borne disease. It is caused by any one of four types of dengue virus, which is transmitted by the bite of an infected female *Aedes aegypti* mosquito.

Symptoms: Common symptoms of dengue include high fever, runny nose, a mild skin rash, cough, and pain behind the eyes and in the joints. However, some people may develop a red and white patchy skin rash followed by loss of appetite, nausea, vomiting, etc. Patients suffering from dengue should seek medical advice.

Treatment: Paracetamol can be taken to bring down fever and reduce joint pains. However, aspirin or ibuprofen should not be taken since they can increase the risk of bleeding. The risk of complications is less than 1% of dengue cases and, if warning signals are known to the public, all deaths from dengue can be avoided.

Investigations: Best test is NS1 and platelet count

POINTS TO PONDER

The outbreak of dengue in the City and Hospital beds are full and families are seen running around in search of platelets for transfusion. However what most people do not realize is that the first line of treatment for dengue is not platelet transfusion. Platelet deficiency is not the cause of death in people suffering from Dengue According to International guidelines, unless a patient's platelet count is below 10,000, and there is

spontaneous, active bleeding, no platelet transfusion is required. The primary cause of death in patients suffering from dengue is blood deficiency in the intravascular compartment, leading to multi-organ failure. Fluid replacement by IV route amounting to 20 ml per kg body weight per hour must be administered. This must be continued till the difference between the upper and lower blood pressure is over 40 mmHg, or the patient passes adequate urine. This is all that is required to treat the patient. Giving unnecessary platelet transfusion can make the patient more unwell.

Formula of 20 : Rise in pulse by more than 20; fall of BP by more than 20; difference between lower and upper BP of less than 20 and presence of more than 20 hemorrhagic spots on the arm after a tourniquet test suggest a high-risk situation and the person needs immediate medical attention.

Rest and drink plenty of fluids and consult a doctor if no relief in fever in 3 days. Home remedies such as goat milk, papaya leaf extract have no scientific proof of being beneficial in dengue fever hence are unreliable.
