REPORT ON PRESIDENTS AND SECRETARIES MEETING OF AFFILIATED SABHAS HELD IN DELHI ON 28 JAN 2018

AGENDA POINTS

Point No 1 Bringing about Qualitative and Quantitative upgrade in the reach/linkage/bonding of the 'Local Sabhas' with Community Members residing within their area of jurisdiction.

- (a) How to make the 'Monthly Meetings' more popular and attractive to draw in large number of 'attendees' particularly the 'youth' and the 'ladies'. Also consider if personal contact/ persuasion can help in affecting improvement in this regard.
- (b) To garner the services of 'technology savy' members to take in hand with or without some outside 'technical help', the organization of 'Data Base' of Members/ Mohyals being serviced by the Sabha.
- (c) Organise the Sabha's 'Designated Point of Contact' with 'e mail ID' and 'Mob No', for qualitatively improving Sabha's response both to the members and the GMS.
- (d) Review the existing format, frequency as also the objectives as presently assigned to 'Annual Melas' as being organized by Sabhas. Consider if the food being provided could be scaled down, more to be a reasonable 'working meal' than an ostentatious fare.

Point No 2 Review of the 'GMS Constitution'

The major changes under consideration are

- (a) GMS Membership
- (b) Annual Affiliation of Local Sabhas.
- (c) All Institutions to be run on 'Self Sustaining Basis'
- (d) Major Roles of Local Sabhas
- (e) Concessions/ Benefits to be made available by GMS

The programme started with the chanting of the Mohyal Prayer by the members, led by Smt Sunita Mehta and Smt Neelima Datta Mehta, after Deep Prajwalan by Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM and honourable members.

Lt Col L R Vaid, Secretary General, welcomed the August gathering, who had assembled in the auditorium after registration and refreshments. He said that, we are all here voluntarily to serve the community as sewaks and looked forward to a meaningful interaction. We should apply our minds on how to reach the underprivileged members of the community and help them in all possible ways we can. In order to keep pace in a competitive world, in a environment of rapid advancement of technology, there is a need to become tech savy for which the youth has to take the lead. Timely delivery of our monthly magazine Mohyal Mitter has been a cause of great concern. After interacting with our youth, we have learnt that the magazine can be uploaded on our mobile phones, which will be soon implemented. He then explained the details of conduct of the programme and the administrative arrangements made for the members. He told the House that Rzd B D Bali, our inspiration and motivator, who has served the community selflessly for four decades, is indisposed and will not be able to attend the meeting. The House wished him good health and speedy recovery. Shri Vinod Dutt, Vice President, was down with fever and has expressed his inability to come for the meeting. He then invited Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM, Sr Vice President, to give the welcome address and to conduct the Business Session.

Lt Gen G L Bakshi, PVSM, extended a very warm welcome to all members who had come for the meeting and said that this was a very important meeting since this was the highest forum which thinks, plans and executes. We should think what we can do for the community and how to take it forward. He said that the Sabhas are closely in touch with the community at the grass root level and GMS is totally dependent on them for execution of the welfare programmes. He requested the speakers to convey their points briefly, when they are invited to share their experiences. Gen. Bakshi explained each agenda point and then invited Presidents of MS Ambala City and MS Gurgaon, who had sent their written

suggestions, followed by others speakers to share their experiences/ views. Most of the speakers shared their experiences on steps being taken to improve interaction in their Sabhas. There was unanimous agreement on changes proposed to be made in the Constitution.

Shri J P Mehta, President MS Ambala City He said that all three wings (Lady, Youth and Main) of the Sabha were active. In order to improve attendance, they celebrate birthdays, marriage anniversary of their members at their bhawan, organize picnics and games for their youth, organize trips to Ashrams, visit each family periodically, invite members from neighboring Sabhas to their meetings and help needy widows and children to get financial aid from GMS. He recommended that Interaction Committee be activated by the GMS.

Shri Sanjay Mohan, President MS Gurgaon He said MS Gurgaon has a fixed place, date and time of monthly meetings which makes it easy for members to come for meetings. In addition members are reminded of the meetings by sending messages via SMS and Whatsapp. Members are encouraged to give their views, sing songs/bhajans, incentive prizes are given to children, social media and print media is planned to be used to share info with members on matrimonial, GMS events, jobs etc.

Shri Rajesh Kumar Dutt, Secretary MS Alwar Finance is needed to run any organization, which can be arranged by voluntary contributions from members, to help needy members of the community. Children should be motivated by publicizing achievements of the mohyals.

Shri Raj Kumar Bali, Vice President MS Amritsar We should glorify our ancestors by celebrating their birthdays etc and find out places where Jathere for our castes are held.

Shri Surender Bali, Secretary MS Pune Telephone directory of all mohyals be prepared and be given to each Sabha , loans be given to students for higher education abroad and when Sabha is not functioning efforts be made to revive it.

Shri P K Dutta, Vice President Sabhas should motivate people who have retired to do something for the society, loans taken for education should be returned when the student starts earning so that it could be used to help someone else.

Shri Ashwani Bakshi, Secretary MS Ambala City Youth should be given responsibility and guided to perform duties.

Shri Rit Mohan, President MS Panipat We should work selflessly for the betterment of the community even without any designation and deal with each other with love and affection.

Shri S K Dutt, Secretary MS Jalandhar Members hesitate to come for meetings due to long distances and lack of information, activities of the Sabha can be advertised through local papers, area of Sabha can be divided into zones.

Shri Vipin Mohan, President MS Yamuna Nagar Mohyal Melas are effective in getting the community together, we should cater to the interest of different segments of our society to encourage them to attend the Sabha meetings, assign work to office bearers and encourage them to produce results.

Lt Col B K L Chhibber, MS Najafgarh Office bearers of the Sabha should be flexible and should give patient hearing to members, important to physically connect with members to know their problems, should have activities of interest to children.

Shri Sanjiv Bali (Bunty), Secretary MS Yamuna Paar Create congenial atmosphere in the Sabha meetings, organize picnics, do publicity of activities done and keep members informed.

Shri Ashok Lav, GMS Local Sabhas to make their web sites and involve the youth in the use of technology to publicise their activities.

Shri Gulshan Vaid, President MS Karnal Students should sign a indemnity bond when they receive financial assistance saying that loan will be returned when they get a job, youth and ladies can be motivated to join the Sabha by organizing Kitty party, tambola and given responsibility.

Smt Ritu Mohan, President MS South Zone We should look after our senior citizens and widows by reaching out to them and give them emotional and economic support.

Shri Harry Chhibber, Secretary MS Ashok Vihar Youth is leader of today and not tomorrow, data base should be centralized under GMS by creating a web site/application linking all Presidents & Secretaries of the Sabhas which will increase outreach of Sabhas and GMS.

Shri Ravi Bakshi, Secretary MS Saharanpur It is easy to find faults rather than make corrections , help weaker sections of our society in any manner, give free tuitions to needy children etc.

Shri Vineet Chhibber, Secretary MS Uttam Nagar Widow pension should not be given without recommendation of local Sabha, youth camp be organized to motivate youth.

Shri Yogesh Mehta, GMS Youth camp will be organized but elders accompanying the youth as guardians should not be more than the youth attending the camp.

Shri Shashi Chhibber, Secretary MS Paschim Vihar Mohyal Melas are an important event which bind the community together and should continue to be held and should be attended by max members of GMS, in the monthly meeting of Sabhas strength is low since only committed members make it a point to attend.

Shri D N Dutta, President MS Prem Nagar Dehradun The two Sabhas at Dehradun combined together and organized a Mela recently, promoting bonding and saving expenses, suggest Sabhas in Delhi consider holding a joint Mela.

Shri Ashok Chhibber, President MS Mehrauli Mohyal Population Census when completed on 31 March 2018 will be the biggest data base of the community, collecting data by meeting the families will also reveal problems faced by Sr citizens, widows and children, for micro financing multi state co operative society can be made by neighbouring Sabhas.

Shri D P Dutta, Secretary MS Jammu & Kashmir The Sabha has issued Identity Cards in the form of Smart Cards which can be used to avail concessions by its members.

Shri Rakesh Kumar Bali, Secretary MS Jaipur Technology be used to form a group consisting of President and Secretary of Sabhas to share information, tambola and kitty can be organized to attract members for meetings, car pooling can be done to attend meetings.

Shri S P Datta, Secretary MS Agra Request we speak only in Punjabi or Hindi during the meetings.

Smt Neelima Datta Mehta, Secretary MS West Zone Honouring parents/grand-parents of our youth is a positive step to involve them in Sabha activities, Melas are important, Interaction with widows is a must to help them overcome their difficulties.

Lt Gen R K Mehta, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, VSM, President MS Noida We should also do something for the country, consider a National level event to highlight achievements of the Biradri when we celebrate 75th anniversary of Independence in 2022, self discipline is very important and should be as expected of office bearers of Sabhas.

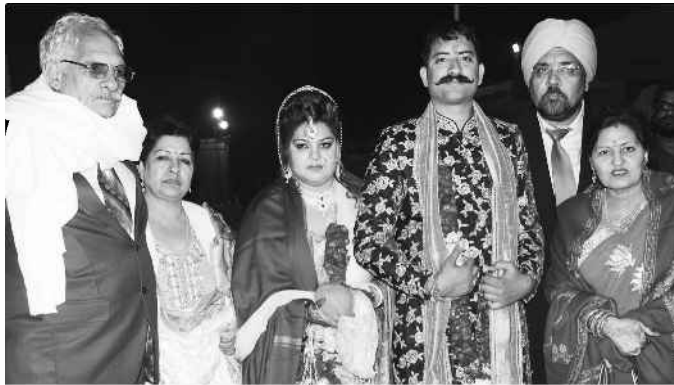

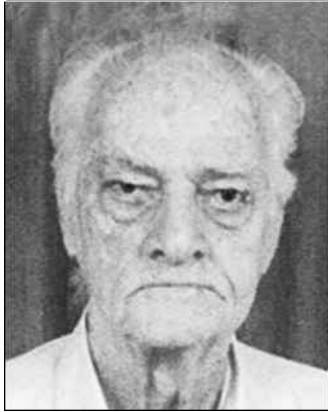
CONGREGATION OF CHHIBBERS
