Shri Kirpal Dass Datta

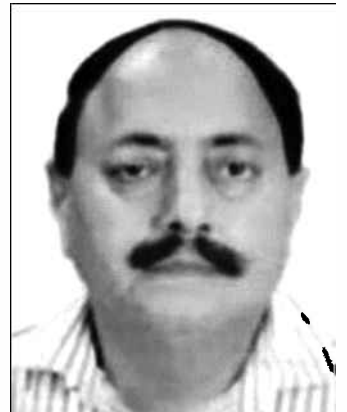

2. Bookings can also be done on telephone and at the counter.
3. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
4. Bookings can be done after payment of 50% of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The deposit can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
5. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
6. Room donors will be charged 25% of the standard room rates (Non Mohyal rates)
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashram is strictly prohibited.
8. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall.
10. Pets (Animals) are not allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Guests are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant, of each room.
12. Guests are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
