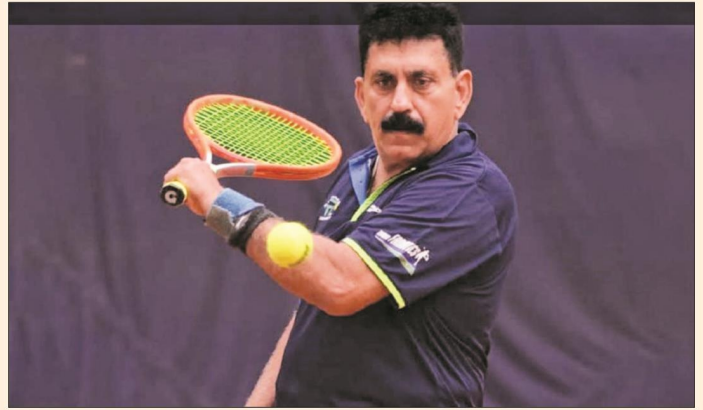

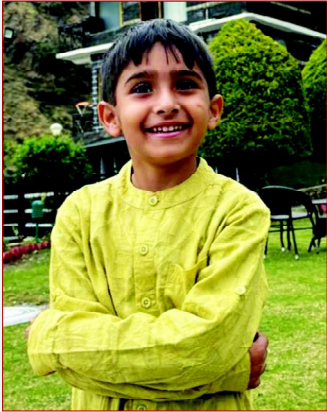

The monthly meeting of the Mohyal Sabha Bholath started with the welcoming of the all the members and the recitation of the

has undertaken, particularly the 'Mohyal Mela', in its first year in office. He highlighted the fact that the team has worked collectively, strictly following the roadmap drawn for the benefit of the Baradari. He insisted that though the team has achieved success in implementing the programmes and policies, yet the path of perfection is never ending and EC will endeavour to make further inroads in innovative ideas and projects for the Baradari.

He highlighted some flagship schemes introduced for the welfare of the community, viz. the Parshuram Annapurna Scheme, which entails not only supporting the needing destitute families but also making these self-sustainable in future. A workshop of 'Skill Development' held for the unemployed of the baradari under the aegis of this scheme, courtesy Shri Gurdial Singh Bali, is testimony of tenacity to implement the scheme in letter and spirit.

He informed house that some important decisions were adopted by the General Mohyal Sabha (GMS) in their latest meeting held at Haridwar, wherein baradari is called upon to prefer the following:

- (a) Should practice use of Punjabi in day-to-day interactions to savour and preserve the original Mohyal flavour,
- (b) Efforts should be made to marry wards within the Baradari first,
- (c) Pension claims must be forwarded for most deserving and needy only and advised that applications should be scrutinized in letter and spirit before recommending by the concerned affiliate units.

President informed that Youth Wing of the Sabha is in its infancy and EC has committed to support it in all aspect so that it starts working as an independent and supporting arm to the Sabha. He appreciated the President of the wing, who has devolved on to some innovative initiatives, and wished him all the best for all engaging initiative it intends to take to involve the youth of the society. He also informed the President Youth Wing that baradari has big hopes from youth, which have niche and important role in all the projects/schemes of the Sabha.

Mr. Mehta highlighted following aspects for the information of the baradari:

- (a) Apprised the house about the dream project of maintenance of the Mohyal Saraswati Mandir premises, installation of Sapt Rishi idols, and construction over the existing setup. Donations have started pouring in and encouraged members of the baradari to contribute wholeheartedly with money and ideas for giving concrete shape to its proposed plan.
- (b) Recorded great appreciation for the Treasury officials of the Sabha for completing entire accounting record for FY 2025-26 within a record time i.e. within a week of closer of financial year, which hitherto had been lingered upto October/November. The record will be put before the Chartered Accountant within a fortnight for finalization and audit of the accounts for this fiscal.
- (c) The Sabha is shortly releasing a Directory consisting of the names and contact numbers of all the registered members on record of the Sabha as on 31st March 2026.
- (d) Recorded appreciation for Sr. Vice President Mr. Narain Bali for fetching benefit under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) of a Govt. department, the details of which will be revealed by General Secretary. He called for a big applause for Mr. Bali.

Thereafter, he requested the General Secretary, Shri M.M. Bakshi, to start the proceedings of the day's agenda.

The General Secretary with "Jai Mohyal" slogan placed 'Affairs of the Year' report before the house thereby fulfilling the promise made before the baradari in last monthly meet. He also placed a word of praise for EC, led by President Shri Anil Deep Mehta, who's coordinated and consensus approach has seen making of a 'Vision Document' and the envisaged plans/ events taking concrete shape in the fixed time frame. The minutes of the previous monthly meeting held on the first Sunday of March 2026 were read out by the General Secretary and were confirmed and approved by the house unanimously.

While presenting the progress report, the General Secretary stated that sincere and honest efforts were made for the betterment and upliftment of the Baradari, keeping everyone's aspirations in mind. Though efforts were put forth with a positive frame of mind by adopting cohesive decisions, yet the team lagged in some areas which need special attention, particularly increasing the membership strength. To achieve these goals, funds are needed, and for this purpose, a separate Bank account has been opened in the name and style of J&K Mohyal Sabha, Jammu (Building Fund). He appealed to the Baradari to donate wholeheartedly towards building fund and declared that names of all those donating more than or equal to 1 11000/- will be prominently displayed in the plaque. The President, General Secretary, and Senior Vice President visited the Guru Sthan of Sadguru Bawa Kanshi Giri Ji, 1008, at Sunderbani last year and conceived the idea of establishing digital/computerized library-cum-Study Centre, wherein various

students can come and study for their career ambitions. On the same pattern, it was decided in the Executive Committee to establish the library for the benefit of the Mohyal Biradari. Mr. Narain Bali led Sabha to approach *Commissioner Sales and Taxation Jammu*, Shri Subash Chhibber ji, to explore funding the library - part or whole amount under CSR activities of the department. Hectic follow-up by Mr. Narain Bali got the library sanctioned from that department under Corporate Social Responsibility Funds, which will hopefully be established shortly at the Sabha thus benefitting the children and elders alike for pursuing higher education or any type of study pursuits. He paid rich tributes to Late Shri Rajinder Vaid (Tamati Ji), erstwhile Senior President, who used to inspire EC for all innovative works.

He also informed that after a lot of searches and detailing a picturesque picnic spot at Pancheri in District Udhampur has been selected for the next picnic of the baradari, and the date has been fixed for 24th May 2026 (Sunday). The detailed schedule and registration date will be circulated on social media platforms before 25th April 2026.
