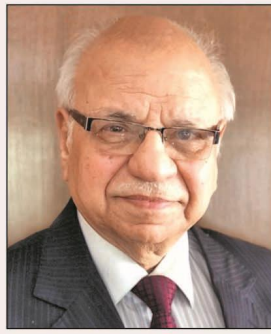

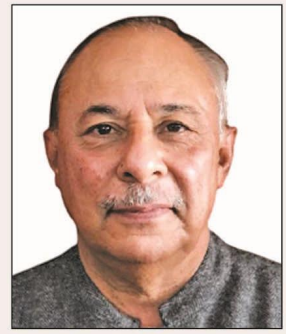

GMS ELECTIONS – 2021 **REVISED SCHEDULE**

The President GMS announced the holding of elections to the GMS Managing Committee, as required by the GMS Constitution, in the Virtual Monthly Meeting of the GMS Managing Committee, held on 13 December 2020 (Sunday) with the Election Committee comprising of

1. Rzd. K.K. Bali — Election Officer (Convener) 2. Dr Subhash Datta — Member 3. Brig Arun Bali (Retd) — Member

Accordingly, the undersigned, viz., the Election Officer (Convener) and Members of the Election Committee, while taking over the responsibility for holding the elections, as announced, notify the Election Schedule as detailed below:

ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE AND CONTEST THE ELECTIONS

- (a) All Mohyal Patrons, Prathishtith Members, GMS Life Members, who have been enrolled as Members on or before 13 December 2020 and Annual Members (for the last three consecutive years) as on or before 13 December 2020 and have attained the age of 18 years shall be eligible to vote and contest.
- (b) The right to vote and contest, as enshrined in the GMS Constitution (as amended on 15 May 2011) vide Articles 7 & 8 as well as Article 22, shall be strictly followed.
- (c) Members wishing to contest may apply for the Nomination Form (having Serialized Nos.) alongwith Rs.100 for Form (at the time of issue of Form) & Rs. 2000 as Security Deposit (at the time of submission of Nomination Form) in the name of General Mohyal Sabha as per Article 8 (iii) & (iv) of GMS Constitution (15 May 2011) from the Election Officer (Convener) or a Member of the Election Committee, **from 22 March 2021 to 10 April 2021** (by 5 pm) at the Mohyal Foundation, A-9, Qutab Institutional Area, USO Road, Jeet Singh Marg, New Delhi-110067.
- (d) A copy of the Electoral Roll will be sent, after the acceptance of the Nomination Form, to the Member wishing to contest and uploaded on the GMS Website. The Electoral Roll will also be sent to local Sabhas for their information and perusal of Members.
- (e) As per the GMS Constitution, a total number of 40 (Forty) Members in the Managing Committee inclusive of a minimum of 5 (Five) Lady Members shall be elected.

OUR VISIT TO NOIDA SHAHEED SMARAK ON 19 FEB 2021

We were invited by Lt General G L Bakshi, PVSM (Retd), to attend "ANNUAL WREATH LAYING CEREMONY" organized by NOIDA Shaheed Smarak Sanstha on 19th February, 2021. We were very keen to visit Shaheed Smarak, as we had also lost our son Maj. Rohit Datta on 1st July, 1997 in Jammu and Kashmir, where he was deputed to an RR Regiment.



First I had decided to go alone to participate, and then my wife Meena also decided to accompany. Gen sahib told that my invitation was valid for both of us. We were not sure of the distance as well as the place, so we started by 08.15 and to our surprise we reached much earlier, so we were the first guests to reach there. Our seats were reserved in the second row along with seats for Mrs & Lt Col L R Vaid (Retd) being the next. Brigadier Arun Bali came and gave us a warm welcome and told us the plans of the ceremony. Later General Bakshi also arrived and welcomed us and explained the arrangements after the function at the Smarak.

Going through the souvenir of 2020, I learnt that Gen Bakshi is the chairman of the Smarak for the last seventeen years from the day it was dedicated to the nation. Brig Bali continues to be General Secretary. There are large number of retired officers from three services holding various positions in the management of the Smarak. The Smarak was dedicated to the nation on 13th April, 2002 by the three service chiefs, and the first wreath laying ceremony was done by Gen N.C.Vij, the chief of armed forces on 13th April 2003. Since then the wreath ceremony has been conducted by chiefs of Army, Navy & Air force. The present ceremony was conducted by the Air Chief Marshal R.K.S.Bhadauria. The park is very well maintained with beautiful green grass, excellent flowers and trees. The National flags as well as flags of all the three services were flying majestically.

When Air chief Marshal Rakesh Kumar Singh Bhadauria arrived, he was received by Gen Bakshi and other dignitaries. He went straight to lay the wreath with air force personnel presenting a salutation, followed by other senior officers and relatives of martyrs from Noida, two principals of the schools and last were two young students from school, one of them was a national player of Tennis. Then there was a photographic session and speech by Gen Bakshi in welcoming the Chief Guest as well as all the invitees. Then the Chief Guest gave a speech which was very pragmatic and to the point. Air chief Marshal then visited all relatives of Martyrs and talked to them to know their welfare. Then we proceeded to the Institute for snacks and tea. Both the ladies went with Gen Bakshi & we went in a separate car. There we had close dialogue with the chief guest. He was also informed about the loss of our son in J&K. We also had a photograph with him.

We have missed this program for the last 17 years. But we are proud that our Mohyal brother Lt. Gen G.L Bakshi has been managing the organization as its chairman since its inception. His dedication and excellent relations with all the three services is well depicted in the management of this Smarak & its functions. We are overwhelmed with the warmth & respect shown to us in this function. We wish to visit this memorable place again & again. Life has given chance to see all present and past officers and gallantry awarded officers of all forces.

We adore the members managing Noida Shaheed Smarak, which is well maintained with green belt of grass beautiful trees and flowers. Nation, Army, Navy, and Air force flags were flying high. The saluting ceremony of the Air force contingency was managed by an officer of the rank of Sqn Leader. Wherever, we see olive green uniform we see our son, Maj Rohit Datta. This remembrance is in our permanent memory. The wreath laying ceremony has helped in reviving this memory.

After the visit to the institute, we decided to go to Lt General Bakshi's home to see Mrs Bakshi who had fractured her feet to wish her speedy recovery. LIFE TIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD FOR Dr PREMA BALI

It is a matter of great pride for the Mohyal Community, that Dr. Prema Bali has been honoured with the LIFE TIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD from the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi, on the 11th January 2021. This



prestigious award was conferred upon her, by Honourable Union Health Minister, Dr Harsh Vardhan, for her pioneering work in India on Marriage Counselling and Sexology as a very unique speciality. She also did a pioneering work on youth and adolescent health as well. She retired from All India Institute of Medical Sciences as Professor and head of Maternal and Child Health and Community Medicine in the year 1993. Since then she has been active in the field and worked as consultant to various prestigious organisations, national and international agencies like W.H.O and U.N etc. A brief excerpt of her activities in the field of medicine is given below.

Excerpts From Prof. Prema Bali's Academic and Professional Career

Dr. Prema Bali, M.D. (P&SM), M.S.P.H. (N. Carolina University, USA, M.C.H & F.P., MAPHA, USA, M.A.M.S, F.I.M.S.A, F.A.M.S, F.I.A.P.S.M, F.N.I.P.H.C.

Dr. Prema Bali has specialised in Community Medicine with a major in MCH and Family Health and has done pioneering work in the field of Sexology and Marriage Counselling. Her work has been acclaimed by the Government of India through its publication in 1966. The importance of her work is evident from the forward written by then, President of India, Dr. S. Radhakrishnan. Dr. Bali gave practical shape to her academic originality, when she started the first ever Sexology and Marriage Counselling Clinic in India at A.I.I.M.S. in 1960. Through this clinic she could reach tens of thousands of needy adolescents and youth, distressed married couples, problem families. The benefits to them, in adding harmony to their sexual and married life, solving complex emotional problems, enlightening the sexual life and in making living pleasurable, speak of the tremendous success of this clinic. It has reverted many from getting nervous breakdowns and committing suicide. This has also demonstrated the work on mental health and preventive psychiatry at the clinical and community level which helped people develop a better quality of life.

Dr Bali has been invited as avisting Professorat the Department of Maternal and Child Health to the Universities of California, Berkeley and in San Diego, to share her experience with the international intelligentsia. She has been also invited to deliver lectures at various universities and

many organisations abroad (viz. Amsterdam University, Holland, Asia Foundation, USA, South East Asia Centre, Berkeley University, Sweden, Marriage Guidance Clinic, Melbourne, Australia. Family Health Dept. Leiden University Holland, Charls University Prague, Czechoslovakia etc.). In recognition of her experience, International organisations like WHO, ESCAP, UNO, etc., have appointed her as Consultant, Adviser and a Member of Expert Group on many occasions. She initiated and promoted the work on sex education in schools and colleges in India. She has been invited to act as adviser to WHO on Human Sexuality, MCH and Family Health at WHO headquarters, Geneva & SEARO on various occasions.

Dr Bali was also elected, as the Chairperson of South East Asia and Pacific region of "International Association of Adolescent Health". She has addressed at various important clubs and gathering like Rotary, Lions Club and many other community organisations on the subject. She reaches the masses regularly through media, to generate the awareness and educate the masses on Family Life Education and Sex Education; Mother and Child Health Care. She has been broadcasting talks every month on the 1st Saturday of every month on YuvVani, All India Radio for over twenty years. She has also been interviewed by BBC London telephonically in series for BBC programmes on Sex Education for number of years.

Dr. Bali has been honoured by important Academics and Institutions for her distinguished and pioneering work in the field of Sexology, Human Sexuality and Marriage Counselling. The Journalist Association Awarded her, a scroll of honour on 'Shanti Divas' for 'writings' on sexual and Marital problems and Marriage Counselling in Hindi and English magazines on to celebrate the 1st Death Anniversary of Smt. Indira Gandhi. She has been honoured by federation of American Indians for Dr Bali's work has received extensive coverage, and has led to her being recognized as a leading authority in the field for which she was invited to address at places like the Institute of Criminology and Forensic Sciences, Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India and Tribal Development and Research Institute, Orissa, Govt. of India. She has been on the Editorial Board of Various National and International Journals and Publications. She has been contributing a regular article on mental Health related to family & Mental Problems in Popular Hindi Magazine Manorama for the past ten years and in the Indo- Russian Magazine "Dialogue". [Apart from professional distinctions, she has also written a philosophical Novel titled 'SANKET']. She had been columnist for Hindustan Times "Birds and Beads". Besides being academician she excels in extracurricular activities like Music, Drama. Dr Bali is also founder, President of Indian Association for Adolescents Health and has been elected as the Chairperson of South East Asia and pacific Region for 'International Assoc. of Adolescent Health'. She has been invited to address at various important clubs and gathering like Rotary, Lion Club and many other community organizations on the subject of Sex and Marriage Counselling. Dr Bali has been on the faculty of All India Institute of Medical Science for over 30 years and retired as Professor of Community Medicine. During this period she has also done lot of original work in the field of MCH. Family Health and Welfare, epidemiology and served on important Committee. Dr. Bali is wife of Sh. Satish Bali who is an architect of great repute.

Members can bring their grievances in the monthly general meeting of the Sabha for redressal. Disciplinary action taken against any

member will be included in the minutes of the meeting of Sabha to be sent for publication in the Mohyal Mitter.

These amendments will be incorporated in the various clauses of Constitution wherever they appear. All the amendments were carried out by the General Body unanimously by raising their hands.

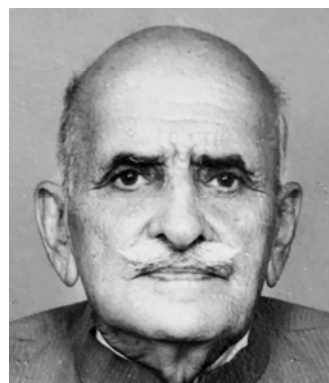

Post retirement, Shri Mohan settled for several years in Lucknow, and later moved to Panchkula, where he immersed himself into his various academic projects.

Shri Ram Tirath Mohan was a staunch and illustrious Mohyal, who believed very strongly in the need to tend and spread the flame of Mohyali in the minds and hearts of the community. He followed his belief, up with great effort and deep dedication towards empowering the Mohyal community. His efforts included the establishment of the Rishte-Naate Committee, a venture targeted at helping young Mohyals find suitable life partners within the community and propagate the feeling of Mohyali pride. It was a pioneering attempt in the field of matrimony within the community.

Shri Mohan strongly believed in the importance of knowing one's roots as the first step in taking pride in one's culture. To this end, he spent decades researching Mohyal roots, following up on obscure, previously unexplored sources of history, revisiting known chronicles and connecting with experts in the fields of archeology, inscriptions, numismatics, et al. The result of years of labour of love

was the opus, 'Afghanistan Revisited: The Brahmana Hindu Shahis of Afghanistan and The Punjab (c. 840-1026 CE)'. In this book, he put together conclusive proof and authentication of the brave and regal heritage each proud Mohyal carries in his heart.

Soon after, Shri Mohan put together 'A Synopsis of Mohyal History', an easy to read handbook for the avid Mohyal, and a summary of his earlier opus. Shri Mohan put together 'History of Mohans: based on Pothi Rai Seegarh and Jangnama Mohana', a short history of the Mohan clan. He had recently completed writing the book "Early Medieval History of India", meant to serve as a reference for history scholars. This will be published shortly.

Shri Ram Tirath Mohan was acknowledged nationally for his research when his writings, titled, "Three Glorious Centuries in Hindu History : Early Indo – Islamic History of Afghanistan and North West India" and "Origin of Caste System and Mohyal Brahmanas", were published in the Itihas Darpan, an erudite national journal.

Never one to sit on his laurels, Shri Ram Tirath Mohan was continuously researching further sources of Mohyal history. Parallely, he was working on a collection of anecdotes, as requested by his family, a repository of interesting, heart touching, and often funny incidents from his long, eventful and fruitful life.

Shri Ram Tirath Mohan's contribution to the Mohyal community has often been acknowledged and upheld in the highest quarters. He was awarded the Mohyal Seva Purskar in 2003 by the General Mohyal Sabha and subsequently honoured with the tile of Mohyal Gaurav. With his passing, Mohyali has lost one of its most stalwart upholders, and the Mohyal community, one of its proudest and noblest sons.

Shri Ram Tirath Mohan is survived by his son, Brig Dipak Kumar Mohan, SM and daughter, Smt Mridula Mehta, his grand children and great grand children. 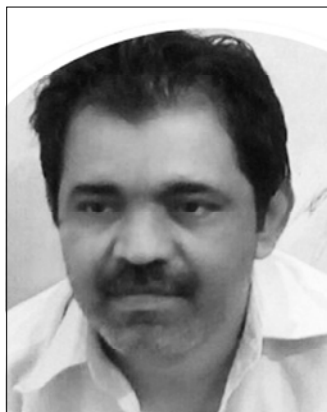

Shri Baldev Raj Mehta (26 May 1926–10 Feb 2021)

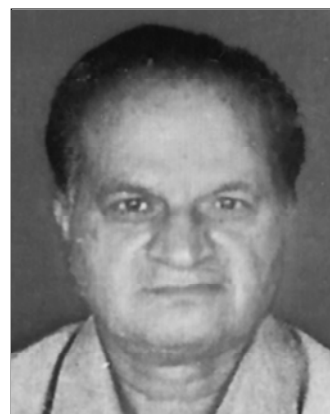

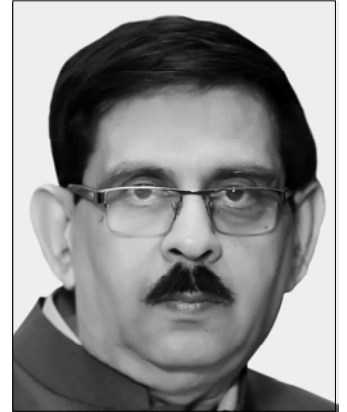
Shri Parveen Vaid (17 Aug 1969-25 Nov 2020)

- Based on the nominations received and after due scrutinisation by the Election Committee, a list of contestants for the election of the GMS Managing Committee 2021 has been displayed on the GMS Notice Board and the website on 8 July 2021 as per schedule. The Ballot Papers will be despatched to all the voters as per schedule.
- Each Voter should darken the circle provided against Forty (40) names, inclusive of a minimum of five (5) shall be ladies for whom he/she wishes to vote using black/blue ink/ Ball Pen and leave the rest of circles blank, as it is:

Note:- (i) If a voter darkens more than forty (40) circles against the name of the contestants, his/her Ballot paper shall be treated as invalid.

(ii) Any ballot paper disfigured or with overwriting on it etc. shall also be treated as invalid. Writing of Name or Signature on the Ballot Paper will render it as invalid.

(iii) Only original Ballot Paper as authenticated and forwarded by the Election Committee shall be accepted.

(iv) As a Special provision, all overseas members settled abroad can also forward authenticated Ballot paper duly filled in to the Election Officer (Convener) through e-mail at id **rzdkkbali@gmail.com**

- This time it has been decided by the Election Committee to provide three envelopes of different colours for the return of Ballot Paper. The Voter after darkening the circle in the Ballot Paper, as stipulated under para 2 above, shall follow the procedure outlined below.

Procedure to be followed for RETURN of completed Ballot Paper to ensure Secrecy

Step 1 The completed Ballot Paper, bearing distinctive number on the left-hand side, shall be inserted in the **PINK** envelope marked **“Ballot Paper Only”** and the envelope shall be properly closed with gum / tape. Please note down your Ballot Number before **closing the PINK Envelope**.

Step 2 The closed **PINK** envelope shall be inserted in the **WHITE** envelope after indicating the Ballot Number on it. The Voter shall write his/her (a) Voter No. (as given on the envelope addressed to Voter) (b) Name and Address and Signature at the space provided and shall close the envelope properly with gum/tape.

Step 3 The closed **WHITE** envelope (containing Ballot Paper kept inside **PINK** envelope) shall be placed in the Self Addressed and Stamped **YELLOW** envelope and the said envelope after closing with gum / tape shall be sent at the earliest so as to reach Election Officer (Convener) latest by **27 August 2021**.

- The **YELLOW** self addressed & stamped envelope containing **WHITE** envelope (in which **PINK** envelope, containing Ballot Paper properly filled has been kept) can also be dropped in person (by hand) by the voter in the Box duly locked and sealed by the Election Committee in the GMS Secretariat for the purpose from 10 am to 5 pm on all working days after making an entry in the Register.
- The Head (or one member) of the family can also drop ballot papers of his / her immediate family members having same Residential address.
- Each Ballot Paper so received would be resealed in the box after the declaration of results.
