IN MEMORIAM



Col Ved Rattan Mohan (1925–1973)

Born in Ghoda Gali, Rawalpindi on 30th July 1925, the first of four children of Shri Narendra Nath and Smt Ram Rakhi Mohan, Col Ved Rattan grew up in a Mohyal family full of promise and enterprise. After completing his studies at D.A.V College and Punjab University, his early years were shaped by rapid change.

In 1947, the family faced the upheaval of Partition, a formative ordeal that grounded his deep sense of community and service. His father acquired the debt ridden Dyer Meakin Brewery in 1949 from the British, and transformed it into Mohan Meakin, and Col V.R. Mohan, carried forward a legacy rooted in both entrepreneurship and patriotism.

The Architect of Old Monk Rum—In December 1954, inspired by the monastic traditions he encountered during a visit to Europe, Col V.R. Mohan introduced Old Monk, a dark vatted rum aged in oak casks for seven years with a signature vanilla spiced aroma. Far from a publicity stunt, the rum's success stemmed from its authentic taste and affordable pricing, qualities that have forged a timeless brand that has become deeply woven into India's social fabric and loved by Indians all around the world.

Business Expansion & Diversification—After his father, Padma Shri NN Mohan passed away in 1969, Col V.R. Mohan took the helm of Mohan Meakin as Managing Director. He oversaw robust expansion: adding three distilleries and two breweries, launching new spirits such as Solan No. 1 Whisky and Golden Eagle Beer, and diversifying into breakfast cereals, fruit juices, glass manufacturing, vinegars, and cold storage, with much-loved brands such as Mohun's Cornflakes and Gold Coin Apple Juice. His vision broadened the company's scope far beyond liquor (necessitated in part by the scare of prohibition) and set it on a path toward becoming a diversified food and beverages group.

Public Life & Honours—Col V.R. Mohan's life was not confined to industry. He was elected Mayor of Lucknow twice, served as a Rajya Sabha member, and became Chairman of the Central Board of Film Certification, an unexpected but impactful role. Recognized by the Indian government for his

contributions, he was honoured with the Awards of Padma Shri in 1967 and the Padma Bhushan in 1971, distinguishing him among India's most honoured entrepreneurs. His charisma was legendary, a favourite with Prime Minister Indira Gandhi, his soirées were graced by Bollywood stars and politicians, reflecting his flair and cultural influence. His contributions to the Armed Forces during the wars of 1965 and 1971 earned him the title of honorary Colonel.

Patron and Practitioner of the Arts—Col V.R. Mohan was a true patron of music and art, often spending hours hand drawing labels or bottle artwork alongside artists, merging his love of aesthetics with business. He regularly hosted classical singers, including legends like Bade Ghulam Ali Khan Sahib, organizing rich mehfils at his home. He himself had a melodious baritone singing voice, with deep knowledge of Urdu poetry. Guests often recall evenings listening to him render ghazals or nazms by heart, a testament to his refinement and sophistication. Art and music are where he escaped from the stresses of industry and politics.

A Family Man with Simple Pleasures—Despite his public prominence, Col V.R. Mohan was deeply family oriented. He loved orchestrating large gatherings revelling in festive holidays with family in Kashmir and Nainital each summer, and winters in Amritsar. These occasions were intentionally rooted, joyous, and built lasting memories among relatives and cousins. To the world he was impeccably stylish and always well dressed, but Col V.R. Mohan was a man of simple pleasures. He preferred dining at roadside dhabas to fancy restaurants, found happiness in tractor rides across farm fields, and delighted in plucking mangoes or sugarcane during harvest. Such moments reflected his grounded nature and love for life's tactile joys.

A Life Cut Short-But a Long-Lasting Legacy—Billy Joel sang, "Only the Good Die Young". His relentless drive to achieve more, to build and to serve, finally took its toll. Despite calls to slow down by his eminent father-in-law doctor, Padma Shri Prof. Baldev Singh, Col V.R. Mohan was not particularly careful with his health, choosing to deal with it quietly and privately. Tragically, he passed away in 1973 at just 47 yrs. Though his tenure as MD lasted only four years, he rapidly revolutionized Mohan Meakin, imbued its brands with identity, and laid the foundation for future diversification. People who met him speak of a lasting, personal connection. He had an uncanny ability to make everyone feel special regardless of social class. No visitor left his home empty handed. He was

generous in spirit, warm in conversation, and left a positive imprint on all who knew him.

He was remembered everyday by his loving wife, Comilla, who admirably brought up their four children after his early demise, Manjula, Rakesh (Rocky), Nilima and Pankaj.

A Final Tribute — Though he departed suddenly, Col V R Mohan's life remains a guiding light. His vision gave birth to an iconic brand, his leadership diversified a business, and his public service elevated his community. He showed that one person, with conviction, creativity, and heart, can shape industries, cities, and more. As his family and community, let us honour him not only by remembering his achievements, but by embodying his spirit: to build thoughtfully, serve diligently, and innovate boldly.

Today, as I, his proud grandson, pay tribute to him on his birth centenary, I ask you to raise a glass of Old Monk and let Col Ved Rattan Mohan's legacy inspire each of us to deepen our family roots, strengthen our community ties, and pursue excellence in all we do.
