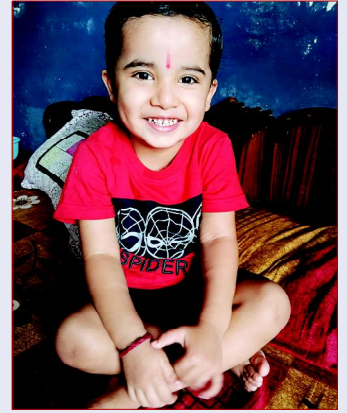

Captain Varun Chhibber, son of Gold Star Mother, Sunita Chhibber and Gold Star Father, Col MP Chhibber, 167 Medium Regiment, at present Secretary MS Noida, was commissioned in the Corps of Signals in June 2005. As a young officer, one of the longest optical fibre cable route was laid. The area with treacherous mountains was prone to landslides but through sheer motivation and perseverance, he achieved this task within the designated time frame. Varun was awarded the Chief of Army Staff's Commendation on 15th August 2008 for his meritorious service in the field area.

After the field tenure Varun voluntarily opted for Rashtriya Rifles and was posted to a sector in J&K. On 2nd February 2009 Varun while leading a patrol on a search and strike mission, answered the call of God and the Country and attained Veer Gati. The warrior had a heroic death on the battlefield and he was martyred on the line of duty. Varun sacrificed his Life so that the nation lives, securing eternal glory.

Gold Star Families are those who raised the Defenders of our Nation and endured the heaviest sacrifice. Varun is survived by his father Col MP Chhibber (Retd) mother Sunita Chhibber and younger brother serving in Indian Navy Commander Ashwin Chhibber. The names of all martyrs are etched in national gratitude in golden letters on the granite tablets of the Tyag Chakra walls of the National War Memorial. They also conduct a Homage Service, where Parents of Fallen Heroes are invited to personally honor them.

Evolution of Generational Mindsets and Opinions

We often hear it at home, “Papa, your thinking is different”, or the younger ones tell us, “Didi, your thinking is different”, But have we ever stopped to ask why it’s different?

The truth is, every generation is shaped by the world it grew up in. When we look at it generation by generation, the differences start to make sense.

- **Grandparents: The Generation of Struggle and Settlement.** They are the heads of our homes. This is the generation that lived through pains we can barely imagine. Their entire life motive was one word “Settle”. They grew up during British rule, fought for independence, and then witnessed the 1947 Partition. After that came the endless effort to rebuild homes, families, and lives from scratch. Later decades brought more turmoil, from the Kashmiri genocide, Punjab riots to other crises. For them, life was never about living for themselves. It was about survival, stability, and making sure the next day was secure. Peace was a luxury they never got to afford.
- **Parents: The Generation of Sacrifice and Family.** Our parents grew up watching that struggle. Many of them moved around, faced poverty, and carried the pressure of elders telling them to “do something and earn”. Most of them were married in their early 20s. That early responsibility forced them to grow up fast. Because they saw hardship, they made one promise to themselves: our children will not go through this. So their motive became: “Live for the family.” They worked to give us education, comfort, and opportunities they never had. For them, personal dreams often came second to the family’s needs.
- **Millennials: The Bridge Between Roots and Modernity.** That’s us. The generation caught in the middle. We are modern, but our roots still pull us back. We are the bridge between emotions and practicality. We say “live for yourself,” but we also hear “do what your parents say”. We want independence, but we also care deeply about izzat and family approval. We chase our dreams, but sometimes we pause because we don’t want to disappoint the people who sacrificed for us. We are the generation that learned to live for ourselves and for our parents at the same time.
- **Gen Z: The Generation of Self and Clarity** and then comes Gen Z. This is the most expressive, most self-aware generation yet. They grew up with the internet, not with scarcity. For them, information, choices, and identity were never limited. So their mindset is open, direct, and global. They prioritize mental health, boundaries, and authenticity over “adjusting” just to fit in. They question old rules not to disrespect them, but to understand if they still make sense. For them, practicality matters, but so does purpose. Work isn’t just about stability, it’s also about meaning. They live on their own terms. Not because they don’t care about family, but because they believe you can respect your roots and still choose your own path. Their opinions may be different from ours, but different doesn’t mean wrong. They are simply the product of a world that is more connected, more vocal, and less afraid to ask “why.”



So why is everyone’s thinking different?

Because every generation answered the biggest question of its time differently:

- Grandparents asked: How do we survive?
- Parents asked: How do we secure the family?
- Millennials ask: How do we balance both?
- Gen Z asks: How do I live authentically for me?

The gap isn’t about right or wrong. It’s about context. Each generation is a reaction to the one before it. Maybe instead of saying “your thinking is different,” we should start asking “what made you think this way?”. Because the moment we understand the why behind a mindset, judgment turns into empathy, and when empathy enters the drawing room then the generational gap finally starts to close.

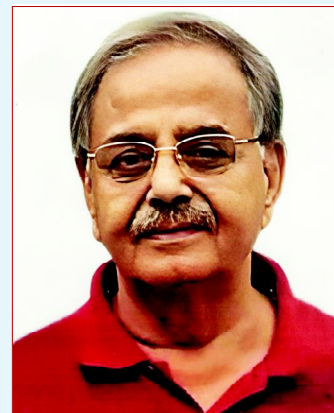

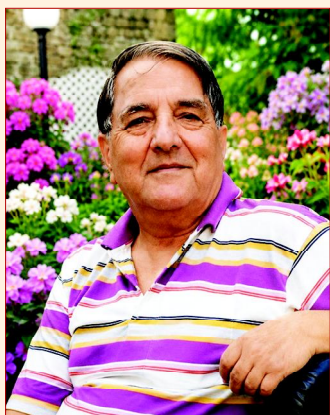
through his exceptional dedication, integrity, and administrative excellence. He was promoted to the Indian Administrative Service (IAS) and retired with great honour as an IAS Officer.
