

My Journey at MERIT



My journey at MERIT began when my first study center, Amity Saket, closed. Despite the challenges of COVID-19, I never felt disconnected from my education thanks to the online classes and continuous support provided by MERIT.

In my 2nd Semester, I was introduced to Santosh Sir, who imparted tremendous knowledge on Computer Organization, and Raveesh Sir, who introduced me to the world of low-level programming. Santosh Sir also aided me greatly in addressing false reports submitted by some students from my class using my name addressed to Santosh Sir through the e-Grievance system of IGNOU. In my 3rd Semester, I was introduced DSA by Kamta Sir and in my 4th Semester to Network Programming by Tusar Sir. The way everything was taught, I never thought I was doing distance studies, it always felt like I can just reach out and will always have an answer. My 5th Semester also went by like a breeze because of the excellent faculty MERIT provided. Towards the end of my fifth semester, I was invited to a TCS-ion event at MERIT. Coincidentally, I had planned to approach Dr. Rattan K. Datta to mentor my fifth-semester project synopsis, and Tusar Sir also wished to discuss something with me. Upon the recommendation of Santosh Sir, Tusar Sir requested me to teach Web Development to the students of COPA/DBSA (ITI), marking the beginning of a remarkable journey.

Dr. Datta helped me a lot with my final project, he helped me understand the structure and scale of my project. His continuous support helped me create a robust system. During my internship at MERIT, I gleaned valuable insights from Meena Ma'am and Dr. Datta, not only on interpersonal skills but also on life lessons. Every faculty member at MERIT played a pivotal role in shaping the person I am today. And now, after a year, I am proud to be a faculty member at the same institute.

In my curious school days, I had heard about the Butterfly Effect, that a flap of a butterfly leads to chaos on a universal scale, but never did I think that the closing of Amity Study Center and me being transferred to MERIT would lead to such an interesting, and adventurous academic journey. MOHYAL ASHRAMS

HARIDWAR AND VRINDAVAN

1. Rooms can be booked by Yatris, 30 days in advance, which can be done, on telephone and also at the counter, in the respective Ashrams. There is no online booking at the Ashrams.
2. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
3. Room bookings will be confirmed, only after full payment of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The donation can be kept in suspense for two months for future booking, if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
4. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
5. Room donors can donate 25% of the standard room rates (non mohyal rates) or pay the prevalent room donation as per their discretion.
6. Donations can be made only in Indian currency. Booking of rooms for foreign nationals (does not include NRI), can only be done after written approval of GMS.
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashrams is strictly prohibited. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
8. Yatri's coming for Asthivisajaran will be given one room on complementary basis, and complementary langar for all members who return back same day after Asthivisajaran .
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall of the Ashram.
10. Pets (Animals) are NOT allowed in the premises of the Ashram.
11. Yatri's are requested to bring alongwith them their photo identity — same is required for each occupant, of each room.
12. Yatri's are requested not to keep the mortal remains (Asthis) of their near and dear ones in their rooms in the Ashram. In order to avoid inconvenience to guests coming from long distances, four lockers have been installed at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar.
13. Rooms in Sewa Sadan, Haridwar can be booked for one month, extendable by 15 days depending on availability of accommodation, only on written request by the senior citizens giving details of their permanent postal address and next of kin, alongwith their medical fitness certificate.
14. Yatri's are responsible for safe custody of their belongings.
15. All payments to the Food Contractor will be made only through coupons issued by the Manager of the Ashram.
16. Facility of free langar, is available only to yatri's staying in the Ashram.
17. Premises of the Ashrams are meant only for boarding / lodging of the Yatri's and No other activity is permitted.




Shri Vinod Kumar Bali

मोहयाल मित्र

सर्वे भवंतु सुखिनः। सर्वे संतु निरामयाः। सर्वे भद्राणि पश्यंतु मा कश्चित् दुःखभागभवेत् ॥

शिव परिवार प्राणप्रतिष्ठा का अद्वितीय अनुभव

हम सभी आस्था से परिपूर्ण होकर मंदिर नियमित रूप से जाते हैं। पर कभी मन में यह प्रश्न नहीं उठा कि एक पत्थर जिस को किसी



कारिगर ने औजारों से मूर्ति का रूप दे दिया, वह किसी प्रकार भगवान बन गए।

इस बार सौभाग्य से जीवन का यह अनुभव भी हमें प्राप्त हुआ, जब मेरे पापा श्री रमेश दत्ता, प्रधान मोहयाल सभा फरीदाबाद जिनके मन में मोहयाल आश्रम, वृंदावन के प्रांगण में शिवजी का मंदिर बनवाने का विचार आया व जनरल मोहयाल सभा के प्रधान श्री विनोद दत्त जी ने इस कार्य के लिए अपनी स्वीकृति दी। उनके साथ ही श्री कामरान दत्ता, आगरा मोहयाल सभा तथा जीएमएस सदस्य ने भी अपना पूर्ण सहयोग दिया। पूरा मंदिर बहुत ही कम समय में तैयार हुआ व प्राण प्रतिष्ठा का शुभ दिन 31 जनवरी 2024 को पंडितों द्वारा निश्चित किया गया। इसके लिए तीन विद्वान पंडित हरिद्वार से चार दिनों के लिए वृंदावन धाम पहुँचे।

तीन घंटों तक सभी देवी देवताओं की, नवग्रहों की व पितरों की पूजा हुई उसके पश्चात शिव मंदिर में यज्ञ हुआ जिसमें उस स्थान की शुद्धि की गई जहाँ पर शिवलिंग स्थापित होना था। मूर्तियों को बनाने के लिए जिस कारिगर व औजारों द्वारा मूर्ति को कष्ट दिया गया, उसके लिए अग्नि ताप हुआ। इसके बाद शिव परिवार को बारी-बारी से जल न्यास, गेहूँ न्यास, घृत न्यास, फल न्यास, फूल न्यास व मिठाई न्यास करवाया गया। अंत में जड़ी बूटियों व औषधियों में न्यास करवाया गया। यह सभी मंत्र उच्चारण के बीच में हो रहा था। विद्वान पंडित सभी उपस्थित जनों को सरल शब्दों में हर मंत्र का अर्थ व विधि का महत्व बताते जा रहे थे।

उसके बाद समय था नगर भ्रमण का, जिसका सारा प्रबंध हमारे आश्रम के कर्मठ कर्मचारियों ने बहुत ही लगन व श्रद्धा से किया। एक ई-रिक्शा मंगवाई गई तथा उसे फूलों, रंगीन लड़ियों तथा गुब्बारों से बहुत सुंदर सजाया गया। ढोल बाजे के साथ शिव परिवार को आश्रम विहार में भ्रमण कराया गया जिसमें आए हुए मोहयाल परिवारों ने, सभी श्रद्धालुओं ने डांस करके अपनी खुशी प्रकट की। हमारे सबसे वरिष्ठ मोहयाल रत्न श्री ओ.पी. मोहन जी भी इस पूरी पूजा विधि में उपस्थित रहे व भ्रमण के दौरान उन्होंने डांस भी किया जिससे उनकी श्रद्धा व जिंदादिली दिखाई दी। डॉ. गीता छिब्र ने सुंदर शिव भजन गाकर सबका मन मोह लिया। नगर भ्रमण के पश्चात शिव परिवार को शयन करवाया गया।

जय श्रीराम के जयकारे के साथ ट्रेन से लखनऊ चल दी। लखनऊ स्टेशन पर रामभक्त कारसेवकों की धरपकड़ शुरू हो गई। हम सभी ग्यारह रामभक्त कारसेवकों को गिरफ्तार कर लिया गया। रामभक्तों से सभी जेलें भर चुकी थी। हमें गौंडा के एक स्कूल में बंद कर दिया गया। रात एक दो बजे हम सभी स्कूल की दीवार फांदकर भाग निकले। रात अंधेरी और अंजान रास्तों से गांव की पगडंडियों से छुपते छुपते एक गांव में पहुँच कर अपना परिचय कारसेवक का दिया तो लोगों ने सरपंच से मिला दिया। सरपंच हिंदू था उसने हमारे रात्रि विश्राम और भोजन की व्यवस्था कर कहा एक मुस्लिम कारसेवा के लिए जा रहा है आप सभी उसके पास रुक जाए वह सुबह आपको साथ ले जाएगा। हमें भय था वह हमें गिरफ्तार न करवा दे। हम सभी के मन में आया “जो प्रभु राम की इच्छा” प्रभु राम की इच्छा से वह मुस्लिम भाई सरयू नदी से नाव द्वारा पार करवा रहा था तो हमने देखा बड़ी संख्या में सांप तैर रहे थे। जब हम नदी पार करके अयोध्या दाखिल हुए तो हमारे पीछे जो रामभक्त आ रहे थे उन पर पुलिस ने गोलियां चला दी बड़ी संख्या में रामभक्त कारसेवक सरयू नदी में बह गए। उस समय जो दृष्य हमने देखा उसे बताते हुए दिल कांपने लगता है।

हनुमानगढ़ी पहुँचकर बड़ी खुशी अनुभव हुई। बड़ी संख्या में रामभक्त कारसेवक पहुँच चुके थे। कुछ समय बाद शांतमय रामभक्तों पर लाठीचार्ज और आंसू गैस के गोले दागे गए। निहत्थे रामभक्तों पर फायरिंग शुरू कर दी गई हजारों की संख्या में बेगुनाहों को मौत की नींद सुला दिया गया। आंदोलन को दबाने के लिए पुलिसकर्मियों द्वारा बड़ी सख्ती बरती गई। सभी रामभक्तों ने अब वापिस लौटना मुनासिब समझा।

माता-पिता बच्चों के लिए एक बरगद के वृक्ष के समान होते हैं जो अंत समय तक अपने बच्चों के सुख हेतु अपना सर्वस्व देने के लिए तैयार रहते हैं। जब तक उनका साथ होता है, हमें इस बात का एहसास नहीं हो पाता। परन्तु उनके जाने के बाद उनके अभाव का दुःख रहता है। पिता तो परिवार के एक महत्वपूर्ण स्तम्भ होते हैं जो बच्चों को हर कठिनाई और परेशानी से दूर रखते हैं। मेरे पापा कैप्टन विश्वनाथ मेहता का जन्म

रावलपिंडी में 14 फरवरी 1927 को हुआ था। उनके पिताजी का नाम स्व. रघुनाथ दास मेहता और माताजी का नाम श्रीमती राजेश्वरी मेहता था।

1945 में फौज में भर्ती होकर अंबाला आ गए। सन् 1982 तक कर्त्तव्यनिष्ठा, सच्चाई व कर्मठता से फौज में अपनी सेवाएँ दीं। तत्पश्चात सेवानिवृत्त होकर, यमुनानगर में अपना घर बना कर ‘यमुना गैसस’ में कार्यरत हो गए और सत्रह वर्ष तक ईमानदारी से अपने पद की गरिमा बनाए रखते हुए कार्यभार संभाला। सामाजिक कार्यों में भी उनका सदैव योगदान रहा। फौज के अनुभव के कारण पत्र आदि लिख कर अनेक विधवाओं की पेंशन लगवाई। स्वयं व इच्छित लोगों से धन एकत्रित कर बिरादरी के अभावग्रस्त परिवारों को मासिक धनराशि उनके घरों तक पहुँचाते थे। जनरल मोहयाल सभा की सहायता से विधवाओं को सिलाई मशीनें दिलवा कर उन्हें स्वावलंबी बनाया। बिरादरी के लोगों के घर-घर जाकर उनके फोन नंबर एकत्रित कर एक डाइरेक्ट्री बनवाई जिससे दुख-सुख के समाचार पहुँचाने में सुलभता हो सके। उनके इस जज्बे को देखकर सन् 2004 में स्व. श्री बी.डी. बाली जी ने उनका सम्मान मैडल, शॉल व ट्रॉफी द्वारा मोहयाल मिलन के अवसर पर यमुनानगर में किया। मोहयाल मित्र के आजीवन सदस्य थे। जीवन के अंतिम समय तक नियमित रूप से कोड़ी आश्रम, वृद्ध आश्रम और अन्य संस्थाओं में अनाज, कपड़ों और दवाइयों आदि की सहायता करते रहे। मेरे पापा सदा खुश रहने वाले, खुशियाँ बाँटने वाले व बच्चों का मनोबल बढ़ाने वाले इंसान रहे।

12 सितंबर 2023 को उनकी जीवन-यात्रा समाप्त हो गई। मेरे पापाजी को मेरी सच्ची श्रद्धांजलि यही होगी कि मैं उनके गुण जो मुझे विरासत में मिले हैं, उनका अनुकरण कर समाज के बिरादरी के और देश के काम आ पाऊँ। ओम् शांति!


