IN MEMORIAM

Shri Ram Tirath Mohan (30 Jan 1926 – 10 May 2021)

With pride and reverence, we remember the life and legacy of Shri Ram Tirath Mohan, whose journey spanned nearly a century of service, scholarship, and devotion to the country and the Mohyal community. Born on 30 January 1926 in Pind Dadan Khan, Jhelum District, Shri Mohan graduated from the prestigious Garden College, Lahore. He lived through the turbulent years of India's freedom struggle, both personally and through family ties – most notably as the brother-in-law of the respected freedom fighter, Late Vaid Om Prakash Dutt.

Following Partition, he settled in Lucknow, serving first in the Uttar Pradesh Secretariat before joining the Indian Foreign Service. His distinguished career took him across continents, where he left an indelible mark on colleagues and friends alike. After retirement, Shri Mohan lived in Lucknow and later in Panchkula, dedicating himself to academic pursuits and community service. A staunch and illustrious Mohyal, he worked tirelessly to nurture pride and unity within the community. His pioneering initiative, the Rishte-Naate Committee, helped young Mohyals find suitable life partners while strengthening bonds of identity and heritage.

He was married to late Smt Prakash Mohan of Kanjur Dattan, a gentle and steadfast partner who remained his quiet source of strength until her passing in 2015.

Shri Mohan firmly believed that pride in one's culture begins with knowledge of one's roots. His decades of research into Mohyal history culminated in the monumental opus - *Afghanistan Revisited: The Brahmana Hindu Shahis of Afghanistan and The Punjab (c. 840–1026 CE)*, which provided conclusive evidence of the regal heritage of the Mohyal community. He later authored - *A Synopsis of Mohyal History* – a concise handbook for the community, *History of Mohans: Based on Pothi Rai Seegarh and Jangnama Mohana*, and *Early Medieval History of India* – a scholarly reference work. His writings, including *Three Glorious Centuries in Hindu History: Early Indo-Islamic History of Afghanistan and North West India* and *Origin of Caste System and Mohyal Brahmanas*, were published in the national journal *Itihas Darpan*, earning him recognition across India.

Never content to rest on past achievements, Shri Mohan continued his research while also compiling a collection of anecdotes at his family's request – a treasury of touching, humorous, and inspiring stories from his long

and fruitful life. His contributions to the Mohyal community were celebrated at the highest levels. In 2003, he was awarded the Mohyal Seva Puraskar by the General Mohyal Sabha, and later honoured with the title of Mohyal Gaurav. With his passing, Mohyali lost one of its most steadfast champions, and the Mohyal community one of its noblest sons.

Shri Ram Tirath Mohan is lovingly remembered by his son and daughter in law, Brig Dipak Kumar Mohan, SM and Smt Neeraja Mohan, his daughter and son in law, Smt Mridula Mehta and Shri Vinod Mehta, his grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. In his memory, the family donated Rs 11,000/- to GMS, towards GMS Widow Fund and Rs 5100/- to MS Panchkula.



वह छोटी उमर में ही विधवा हो गई थी मेरे पिता जी उस समय 3 वर्ष के थे। भाई फकीर चंद बाली की मदद एवं कड़ी मेहनत से उन्होंने अपने दोनों बेटों का लालन पालन व शिक्षा का दायित्व निभाया। वह एक धार्मिक एवं संतुष्ट महिला थी। उनकी सादगी और मेहनत ने मुझे हमेशा प्रेरित किया था। वह मुझे सिखाती थी कि जीवन में सफलता पाने के लिए शिक्षा के साथ-साथ मेहनत और संघर्ष भी जरूरी है।



मैं अपनी दादी से बहुत प्यार करता था और उनकी मेहनत और सादगी की कद्र करता था। वह मेरी सबसे अच्छी शिक्षिका थी, जिन्होंने मुझे जीवन के सबसे महत्वपूर्ण सबक सिखाए थे।

दिवंगत पूर्वजों की याद में परिवार द्वारा जी.एम.एस. के पास दो ट्रस्ट "मेहता मथरा दास, लक्ष्मी देवी और सीता देवी छिब्बर" के नाम से संचालित हैं जिनमें परिवार के सदस्य समय-समय पर योगदान करते रहते हैं।

भले ही इस नश्वर संसार को अलविदा कह गए हों, पर उनकी मधुर स्मृतियां, सदा मुस्कुराता चेहरा, मिलनसार स्वभाव और अपनत्व की गर्माहट सदैव हृदयों में जीवित रहेगी।

वे स्वर्गीय श्री बलदेव मित्तर मोहन एवं स्व. श्रीमती शशि मोहन के लाडले सुपुत्र थे। माता जी के निधन के पश्चात

पिता-पुत्र ने एक-दूसरे का सहारा बनकर जीवन जिया, पर लगभग दो वर्ष पूर्व पिताश्री भी उन्हें छोड़कर परलोक सिंघार गए। इस असहनीय वियोग के बाद रोहित मानसिक और शारीरिक रूप से स्वयं को अकेला व अस्वस्थ अनुभव करने लगे।

उनके जीवन में मामा श्री विनोद कुमार दत्त, प्रधान जीएमएस का स्नेह छाया बनकर साथ रहा। वे उन्हें खन्ना अपने पास ले आए, जहाँ पिता स्वरूप मामा का वात्सल्य और भाई विदुर दत्ता एवं चाणक्य दत्ता का सम्मान व स्नेह उन्हें मिला। परिवार के बीच उनका मन लगने लगा। रोहित ने अपने कर्मक्षेत्र में भी पहचान बनाई। उन्होंने सुपर मिल्क प्रोडक्ट्स (चाणक्य डेयरी) की मार्केटिंग पंजाब और हिमाचल प्रदेश में कर ब्रांड की पहचान मजबूत की। जालंधर में उन्होंने एक कोचिंग सेंटर संचालित किया, जहाँ से शिक्षित कई युवा आज अपने-अपने क्षेत्रों में स्थापित हैं। वे नेटवर्किंग कला के कुशल ज्ञाता थे और लोगों को जोड़ने में अद्भुत क्षमता रखते थे।

पिता के देहांत के बाद अस्वस्थ चल रहे थे रोहित को अपने पास रखकर हर संभव देखभाल की। बाद में ज्ञात हुआ कि रोहित एक गंभीर बीमारी से पीड़ित हैं। दत्त जी ने उन्हें लुधियाना के प्रतिष्ठित मेडिकल कॉलेज में भर्ती कराया, तत्पश्चात मोहाली के प्रसिद्ध अस्पताल में भी इलाज करवाया। किडनी प्रत्यारोपण तक की तैयारी चल रही थी, परंतु नियति को कुछ और ही मंजूर था। जीवन संघर्ष से जूझते हुए रोहित अंततः 1 फरवरी 2026 को परमात्मा में लीन हो गए।

11 फरवरी को जालंधर में आयोजित शोक सभा में दिवंगत आत्मा को पुष्पांजलि अर्पित की गई और परमपिता परमात्मा से उनकी सद्गति हेतु प्रार्थना की गई। अंतिम संस्कार
