REPORT ON PRESIDENTS AND SECRETARIES MEETING OF AFFILIATED MOHYAL SABHAS HELD AT MOHYAL ASHRAM HARIDWAR 6 MARCH 2026 TO 8 MARCH 2026

Presidents and Secretaries Meeting of Affiliated Mohyal Sabhas, was held at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar. For the first time, Spouses of the Presidents and Secretaries were cordially invited, who participated with full enthusiasm. Registration and allotment of rooms was done, on arrival of members at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar on 6 March 2026. Arrangements were made for the conduct of the meeting in the Park adjacent to our Ashram, by making a colourful covered Pavilion, decorative stage, proper seating arrangements and audio system.

Health checkup camp, was organized kind courtesy Mohyal Ratna Shri P.K. Dutta, Sr Vice President GMS. A Medical Laboratory was created in the Library room. Blood samples (which included several tests), were taken of volunteers after recording their names and mobile numbers, by specialized healthcare professionals at 0730 hrs on 7 March 2026. He requested Shri Raj Bakshi, Secretary Public Relations GMS and Vice President MS Amritsar to speak to the lady members and request them to share their views. There was a healthy interaction and members came on the dias and put across their views. Everyone appreciated the efforts put in by GMS, in organising events, going into minutest details, to promote Women and Youth Empowerment and Match Making Get-Togethers, and evolving programmes for the welfare, progress and prosperity of our Community. The following points emerged after discussion by the members

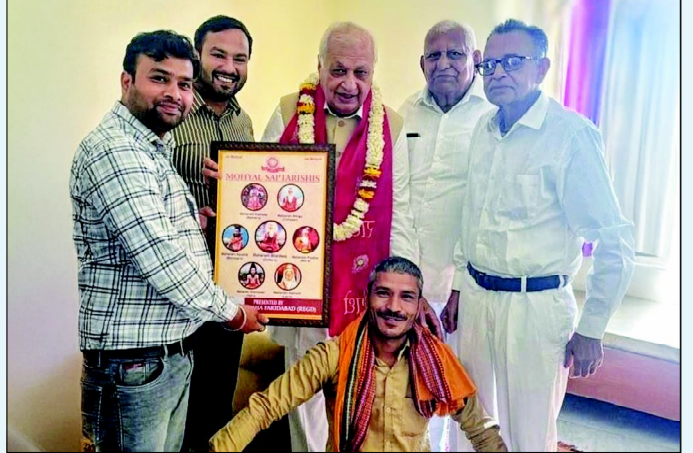
- (a) Eligible Boys and Girls for marriages, be encouraged to find the life partners within the Community – simple marriages without any dowry.
- (b) Preferably there should be one local sabha in a city / town.
- (c) Local Sabhas should be encouraged to get donations on behalf of GMS.
- (d) Consider holding Singing Competition for the Youth (Boys and Girls).
- (e) Career counseling should be conducted which will help the youth to decide on the profession to be chosen.
- (f) Youth should be made aware of our Mohyal Customs.
- (g) Grievance Committee should be formed and Interaction Committee should be activated.
- (h) Applications for Widow Financial Aid should be properly scrutinised to help only the needy widows.
- (i) We should encourage speaking in Punjabi at home and in all platforms.
- (j) Youth programme should be held at different locations.
- (k) Mohyal Prathana should be followed in letter and spirit.
- (l) Mohyal Ashrams to be opened at Ayodhya / Varanasi etc

The following Resolutions were unanimously adopted

- (a) No Mohyal Child will be deprived of education due to lack of funds. We will also help obtain, interest free Bank loan for higher education.
- (b) Youth will be helped to get suitable Jobs.
- (c) Applications will be properly scrutinised to ensure that only Needy Widows are given financial aid and thereafter we will consider increasing financial aid from Rs 1500/- to Rs 2000/- per month.
- (d) Marriages when solemnised should be simple, avoid non-veg food and drinks and will be without dowry.
- (e) Students excelling in studies / cultural activities / any other achievement, will be honoured and must be encouraged to attend the Pratibhashalee Mohyal Vidyarthee Samman held every year.
- (f) We are committed to empower Youth and Women.

Raas Leela (Divine mystical dance) by Gulshan Musical Group (Professional Group) was organised at 8 pm on 7 March 2026 at the same venue, which was a great hit and immensely enjoyed by all the participants. This was followed by dinner at Mohyal Ashram Haridwar. Members dispersed after breakfast on 8 March 2026.

First Session: In the first session, each family was invited to introduce themselves. The candidates, along with their parents, shared their introductions and also expressed their expectations from their prospective partners. This helped everyone become familiar with one another in a comfortable environment.

Second Session: After a short tea break, the second session began. All the candidates were divided into different groups and assigned discussion topics. Everyone participated actively and sincerely in the discussions.

The youngsters expressed their views confidently and with open minds, sharing their opinions while patiently listening to others. The atmosphere was very positive, and the participants enjoyed each other's company while discussing various topics. It was wonderful to see young people interacting meaningfully with one another. The periodic monthly meeting of the Biradari was held at Mohyal Saraswati Mandir, Jammu, under the president ship of Shri Anil Deep Mehta. Shri Vipin Bali (President, District Unit Poonch) and other veterans were special invitees to the meeting.

The meeting commenced with the recitation of the Mohyal Prayer by the President of the Youth Wing of the Sabha, Shri Baleshwar Bali, followed by observing a two-minute silence to pay tribute to the departed soul of Smt Ramesh Bala Dutta, wife of late Shri Krishan Kumar Dutta, resident of Trikuta Nagar, Jammu.

Course and Future Roadmap - Extending a warm welcome to the gathering, Shri Anil Deep Mehta informed the house that feedback and constructive suggestions emanating from the monthly meetings are not only a source of encouragement for the Sabha but also act as catalysts in deciding its future course.

Addition / Alteration and Construction of Sabha's Property

Performance— Before taking up the next agenda item, the General Secretary reiterated that the present team would soon complete one year in office. 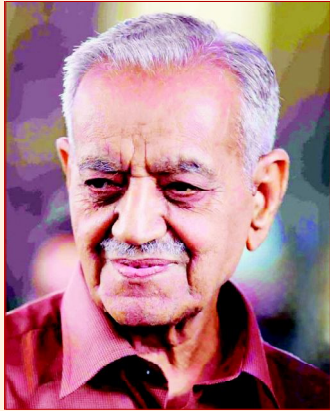

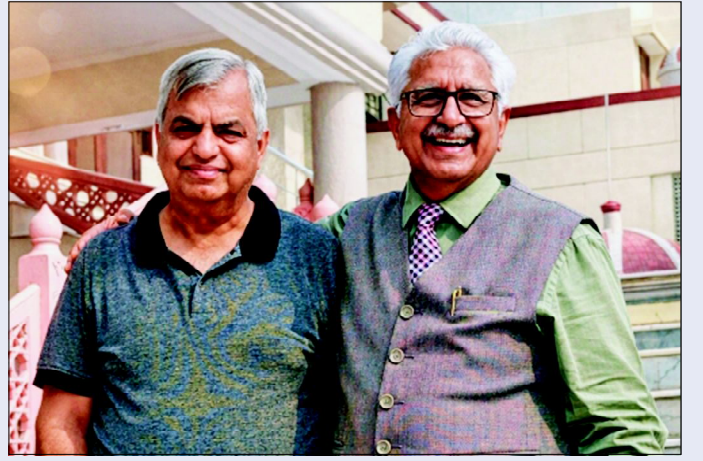
