It is a matter of pride for all of us that our apex body, General Mohyal Sabha, completes 125 years since its inception. Perhaps it is one of the oldest functional societies with our Mohyal Mitter having already been adjudged as the oldest running magazine in the country as per Limca Book of Records. While we have every reason to congratulate ourselves, we feel mighty proud of our forefathers who had the perspective and vision to carve out a “Service Wing” of the Community as early as 1891 to function as a bridge between ‘haves’ and ‘have nots’ to help the needy, besides which, it also provided a platform to the Mohyal Community for emotional integration among themselves.




Furthermore, it is a matter of gratification that our elders at that time had a clear vision on necessity of higher education for our children for the future growth. At that time, nationalism was at its peak – DAV was established in 1885, and Lahore was the nerve center for higher education in the then Punjab where most of Mohyal population was settled. Despite all financial constraints, it is heartening that they established Mohyal Ashram in Lahore itself, next to DAV College, which was to be the Boarding House provided at a nominal cost so that our children aiming at higher education could be benefitted - which became a big boon !

The partition of the country dealt a big blow to everyone but our community suffered the most as they were uprooted from their “habitats”, mostly in villages, and were scattered all over the country for rehabilitation. It was at that crucial time that GMS stood like a rock, became a symbol of Mohyaliat and against heavy odds kept it afloat and took all possible steps to keep our identity and unity intact.

Today, after 70 years of Independence, we can say with pride that the enterprising Mohyal Community has come up exceedingly well and perhaps it is one of the most prosperous Community in the country - aiming high and playing a heroic role in the mainstream of the country. Simultaneously, GMS today stands tall, united, financially stable and epi-center of all Mohyal activities. It is a big satisfaction that the sapling planted by our elders has grown many times more with fruit bearing trees.

We are proposing to celebrate this big event early next year in Delhi in a befitting manner, and pay our obeisance to our esteemed founders to whom we owe lot of debt and gratitude and would look forward to welcome you for the same. In the meantime, we are first holding a function at Yamuna Nagar on 11th September 2016 to celebrate Mohyal Diwas & to lay down the “Foundation Stone” of Mohyal Bhawan Yamuna Nagar with multiple facilities which should be beneficial to our Mohyal families settled in and around Yamuna Nagar – which, it is stated is the largest Mohyal population after Delhi. This will be another feather in the cap of GMS and the Mohyal Community – towards which we seek your blessings and support.

1. The first semester classes of COPA trade (August 2016 session) have commenced in MERIT, from 1st August 2016.

Kamla Bakhshi was born on 3 June 1930 at Delhi to Dr Sri Ram Mohan and Smt



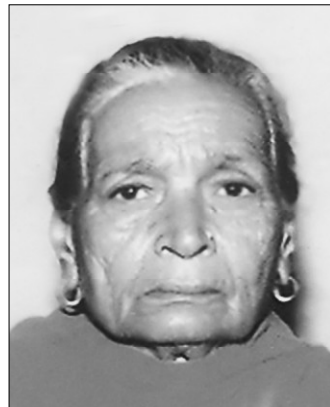
