




Mundan Ceremony

Annika Sharma, Millburn High School, is among 80 students selected as one of the 2018-2019 Governor's STEM Scholars. She will learn from and network with New Jersey STEM professionals, research organizations, academic institutions and state policymakers throughout the year. Along with her fellow scholars from universities, high schools and academies throughout New Jersey, she will attend STEM conferences, field trips and participate in a team-based research project.

The Research and Development Council of New Jersey use rigorous criteria to select the students from over 500 applicants that includes character, leadership ability, and STEM aptitude. Established in 2013, the Governor's STEM Scholars program is a public-private partnership between the Governor's Office, Research & Development Council of New Jersey, New Jersey Department of Education and Secretary of Higher Education. Its ultimate goal is to develop the state's pipeline of STEM talent further while promoting economic development.

■ **Mayank Vaid** who set record as the fastest Indian Ultraman at Ultraman Australia 2017, has just completed the Enduroman Arch to Arc Triathlon in June 2018. The Enduroman is an ultra-distance triathlon. The triathlon starts with an 87 mile run (140 km) from London's Marble Arch to Dover on the Kent coast, then a cross-Channel swim (shortest distance 21 miles/33.8 km) to the French coast, and finishes with a 180-mile (289.7 km) bike from Calais to the Arc de Triomphe in Paris.

The clock starts at Marble Arch, London and stops at Arc de Triomphe, Paris. Mayank, together with his teammate David Gething, accompanied by his wife Theresa Vaid who was his support crew completed this challenge in a time of 78 hrs, of which he did a relay swim across the English Channel in 12.24 mins. Due to the tide, currents and flooding from Atlantic, the team ended swimming 55.2 kms. Mayank, 85229686227, is a Hong Kong based Solicitor, Indian Advocate and a Certified Patent Valuation Analyst. His family comprises his wife Theresa, and two young boys. He originates from Bilaspur, Himachal Pradesh.

He works in-house as the Intellectual Property Director – Asia Pacific and China for Louis Vuitton. He strongly supports a focus on health and family.

Gradually, they rule out many options from our lives because the comfort of old habits prevents us from attempting anything new. You can call it a desire to live in our comfort zones. But sticking religiously to old habits keeps us from evolving and becoming sharper. We are witnessing massive changes around us in this era. It is not easy to keep abreast of all

those changes but it becomes almost impossible if we are bogged down by our old habits. Here are a few examples:-

- **Following a fixed routine** If you are doing today what you have been doing for the bygone weeks, months or years, where is the need for your brain to strain itself. It will snooze in it's comfort zone. But like any other organ of the body, the brain too needs exercise in order to work at its optimum capacity.
- **Refusing to try anything new** This is partly like the aforesaid habit but it has wider ramifications. Technology has invaded every aspect of life today. Numerous needs can be fulfilled at the click of a button but if we continue to do things the old way, the brain slows down and our personality loses it's spark. We also waste a lot of time doing what could have been done in a jiffy.
- **Keeping aloof** It is not media alone which informs us about the developments which can make life easier for us. People around us can fill in the gaps if our knowledge is incommensurate, and the tech-savvy can be roped in to learn the tricks.
- **Not asking questions** We avoid asking questions in order to conceal our ignorance but in the process we become more and more ignorant. We may pretend that we know it all but others can easily see through this facade. This tendency is responsible for us remaining ignorant in many fields.
- **Rejecting criticism** There are two kinds of critics- those who wish to pull us down and those who have our welfare at heart. When we reject the second kind we lose an opportunity to improve ourselves.
- **Lack of curiosity** Newton's curiosity about the reason for an apple falling off the tree led to phenomenal changes in our views about the world we inhabit. It is curiosity which introduces us to new domains and enlarges the field of our knowledge.

Not only do above habits prevent us from keeping pace with this fast changing world, they also nibble at our self esteem. Changing the very basic ways of conducting our affairs is certainly not easy, but incorporating at least some of the required changes in our lifestyles will enable us to become one of a cluster and not an isolated dot.

2. Bookings can also be done on telephone and at the counter.
3. Rooms can be booked on twin sharing basis (2 adults and a child below 12 yrs) for a maximum of 3 days. Check in / Check out time is 12 noon.
4. Bookings can be done after payment of 50% of room donation. The amount will be forfeited if booking is not cancelled at least 48 hrs before booking date. The deposit can be refunded or kept in suspense for two months for future booking if cancellation is done 48 hrs in advance.
5. Bulk booking (more than 3 rooms) can be done only after prior written approval of GMS.
6. Room donors will be charged 25% of the standard room rates (Non Mohyal rates)
7. Consumption of tobacco, liquor and non-vegetarian food in the premises of the Ashram is strictly prohibited.
8. Persons in inebriated condition will be denied entry to the Ashrams.
9. There is no room service — meals have to be taken in the Dinning Hall.

MOHYAL HISTORY—AN ISSUE OF CONCERN

Chach and Dahir Dynasty (the ancestors of present day Chhibbers) ruled over Sindh for eighty Years (632-712). During this period they warded off fourteen attacks from the Arabs – the super-power of those times – but lost in the fifteenth. Ancestors of Datts and Vails ruled over Kabul and Punjab for more than a century and a half (up to 1026), astride the Khyber Pass, defending the north-western border of India.

When India lost its freedom and succumbed to foreign rule, Mohyals continued to resist and offer martyrdom. Among them, martyrdom of Bhai Mati Das and Sati Das is etched too deeply in the Mohyal consciousness. Before Guru Tegh Bahadur was killed under the orders of Aurangzeb, for his refusal to accept Islam, his three associates were subjected to inhuman torture to break the resolve of the Guru.

Of these three martyred associates, Bhai Mati Das and Sati Das were brothers – great grandsons of Baba Prag Das, a Chhibber of the village Karyala, now in Pakistan. The third, Bhai Dayal Das, was not a Mohyal. According to Shri PN Bali (page 88 of third edition), Dayal Das was from Kohli caste. Whatever his caste, it is a universally recognized fact that he was not a sibling of Mati Das or from their family. In scores of books on the subject written by Mohyals and Sikhs, there has never been any doubt on this issue. This has been rechecked from all Mohyal History books written in the twentieth century - by Russel Stracey (1911), Raizada Hari Chand Vaid (1923), Chunilal Datt (1955) and PN Bali (1986).

It appears that in recent times a popular Mohyal scholar started writing, without citing any evidence, that Dayal Das was the third brother of Mati Das and Sati Das, and so a Mohyal Chhibber. This incorrect statement is being picked up by our writers of books and articles because of its sentimental appeal. *This issue needs to be discussed by the writers/intellectuals associated with Mohyal History.*

During 1990s questions were raised, by Mohyal scholars and others, that in the absence of any supporting documents and absence of any mention about these in other history books, tall claims of Mohyals were like fairy tales – and certainly not history.

With a lot of laborious research, all claims of Mohyal rule in Sindh, Kabul and Punjab, as also other important events, have been re-written with dependable documentation in our Mohyal History books published during the last one decade. Research papers have been published in the Research Magazines, so that Mohyal History receives the scrutiny of professional historians. New books on Mohyal History are being published through established publishing Houses, to reach out to a wider circle of non mohyal readers. All this is to establish the credibility of Mohyal History as a glorious chapter which had been missing from the narration in the mainstream history of India. Mohyal History should not remain a private gospel of our own community.

I fervently request that our scholars like Dr Ashok Lav, Dr Lajja Devi Mohan, Shri Vinay Mehta, Maj Gen. G. D. Bakshi, Lt Gen H. C. Datta, Shri Budheshwar Singh Bhimwal and others give their views about the caste of martyr Bhai Dayal Das.

to contribute Rs.200/- yearly towards welfare fund. (2) The write-off loan or bad debts in case of extreme compassion after approval of general body. (3) Further a gift cheque of Rs.1100/- is given as shagun to the Son/Self (male) Member on his marriage. (4) Further a gift cheque of Rs.2100/- is given as shagun to the daughter/self (female) member on her marriage. (5) Awards to brilliant students is continued as usual, the students are given prizes worth Rs.1500/- to their parents who secured more than 80% marks in 10th and 12th standard examination. Managing Committee congratulates all such students; and parents on the brilliant performance of their wards and hope that they shall do better in their studies in coming years. ऐसी धार्मिक आस्था है कि इस गुफा में रखी शिव पिण्डियों के दर्शन से हर मनोकामना पूरी हो जाती है। ऐसा कहा जाता है कि इस गुफा को स्वयं भगवान शिव ने ही बनाया है।

ऐसी कथा है कि भस्मासुर ने भगवान शिव को प्रसन्न करके वर मांगा कि जिसके सिर पर हाथ रखे वह भस्म हो जाएँ। वर मिलते ही वह भगवान शिव के सिर पर हाथ रखने के लिए आगे बढ़ा। फिर दोनों में भीषण युद्ध हुआ। भगवान शिव बचने के लिए इसी गुफा में छिपे थे। भस्मासुर का अन्त भगवान विष्णु ने स्त्री रूप धारण कर किया। भस्मासुर ने उन पर मोहित होकर उनके साथ नृत्य किया। नृत्य के समय उसने हाथ को जैसे ही अपने सिर पर रखा वह भस्म हो गया।

इस गुफा में पार्वती, गणेश, कार्तिकेय, नन्दी की पिण्डियाँ भी हैं। इस गुफा का दूसरा सिरा अमरनाथ गुफा में निकलता है।

शिव खोड़ी के लिए 3.5 किलोमीटर पैदल या खच्चर पर यात्रा करनी पड़ती है।




